Glossary



- GPS point or Waypoint: a single point on the earth defined by a longitude and latitude.
- Route: succession of GPS points connected by straight lines.
- Trace: a route that has already been travelled.
- Route: set of GPS points linked together by straight lines to calculate route proposals.
- Over Track: calculation of itinerary proposals.
- Backtrack: track drawn on the map as you travel.

Offline card management 1



To manage offline maps, select the map type, scale and zone(s) required. The system shows you the number of maps you have selected, as well as the available space.

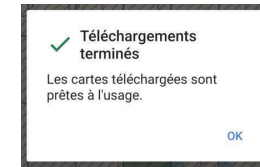
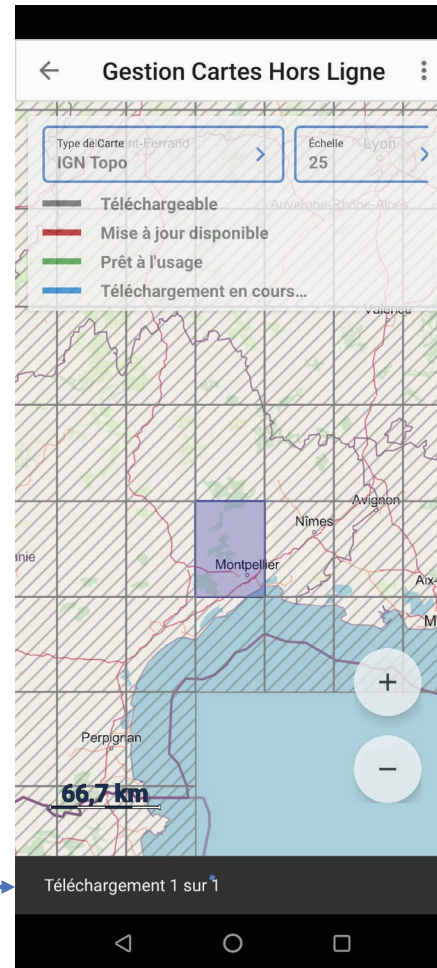

Offline card management 2

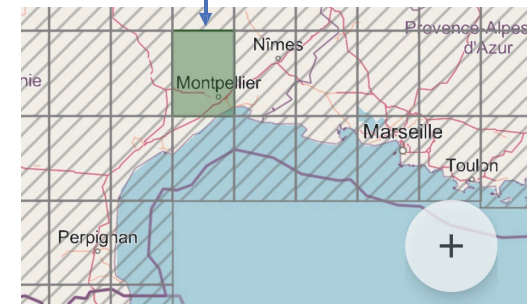
During download, the selected area changes from gray to mauve.

If a downloaded zone turns red, an update is available. Simply follow the same procedure.

When the download is complete, the system indicates this and the downloaded area turns green.

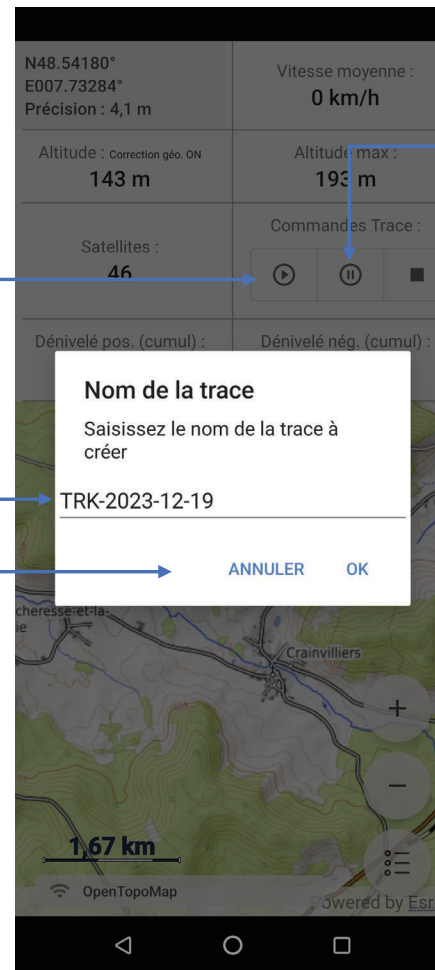


Track recording



To access the track recording menu, display the information menu and click on 'Play'.

A window appears, prompting you to enter a track name. Once the name has been entered, simply confirm with 'ok'.



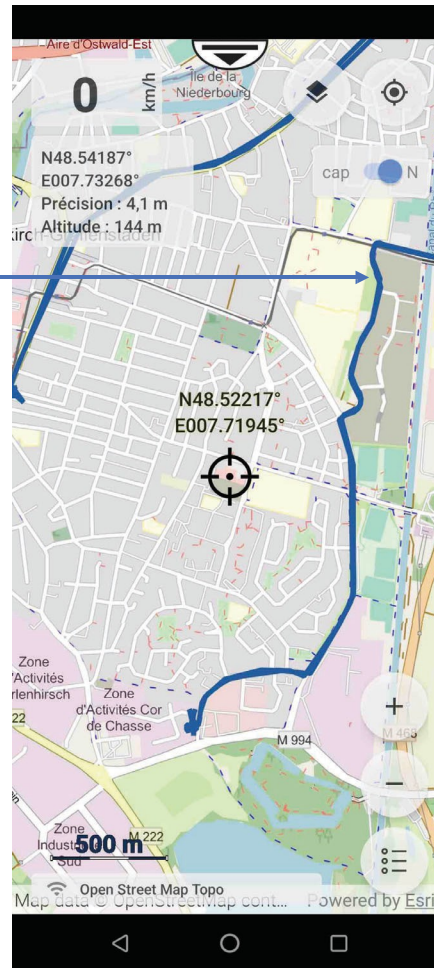
You can pause recording at any time.

Or stop it.

Tracks are managed in the 'Library' menu.

Back track 1

The back track corresponds to the route I've just taken and is marked with a blue line.



Backtracking is managed via the 'Library' menu.



A simple click on this track brings up a menu that allows me to :

- to delete it,
- hide it or
- to save it.



If I decide to delete it, I have to confirm.

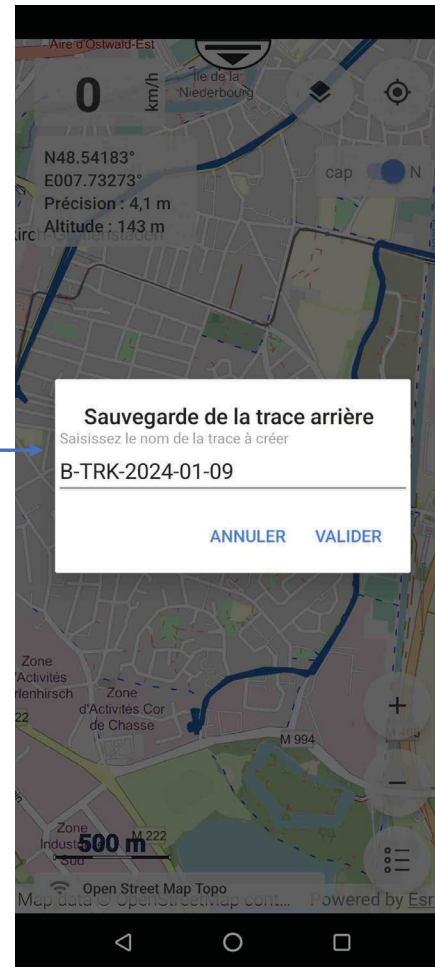


Rear trace 2

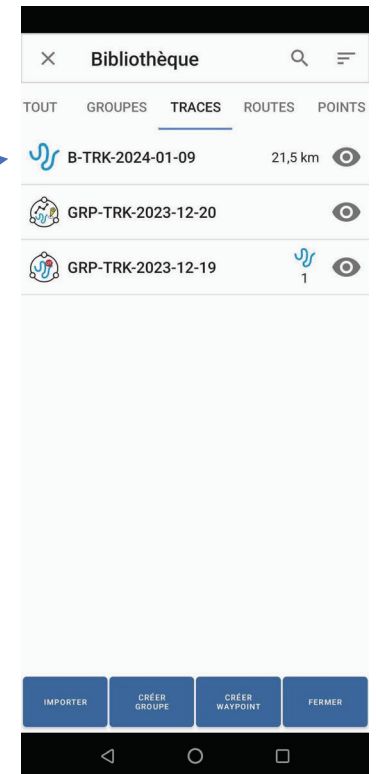
If I want to save it, I can enter a name.

The basic name will be B-TRK (Back Track) followed by the current date.

Once validated, the system confirms the save.



And I find the trace saved in the 'Library'.



Quick Menu Card 1



A long press on the map takes you directly to the 'Quick Map Menu'.

Go to (on course), navigates on course from your position to where you clicked on the map.



Goes to the 'Route menu'.

Creates a GPS point where you click on the map.

Creates a route on the map.

To access the GPS points menu, simply click on the point or go to the 'Library' menu.



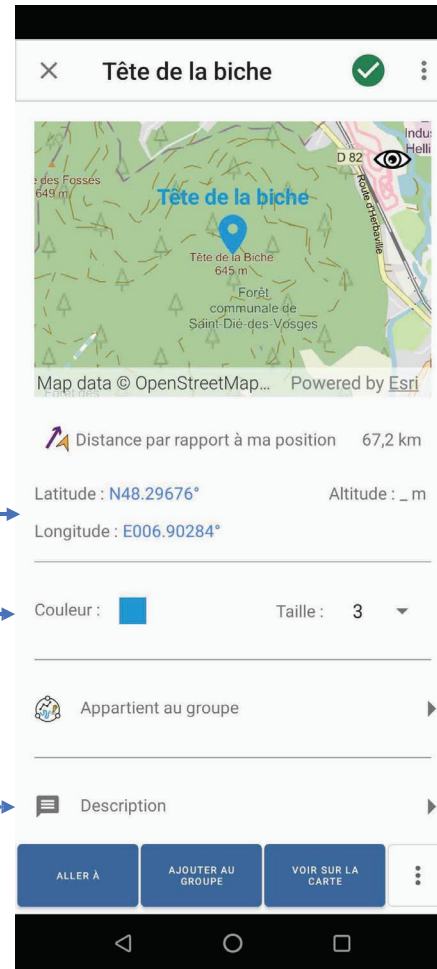

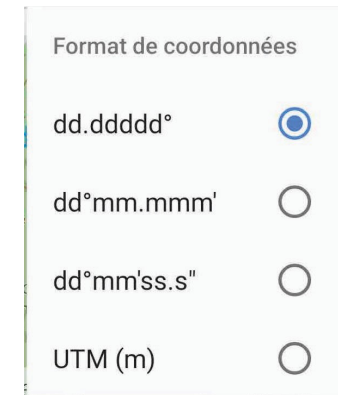
GPS point (Waypoint) 2

Course creation 1

Route creation allows you to create a route with 2 or more points.

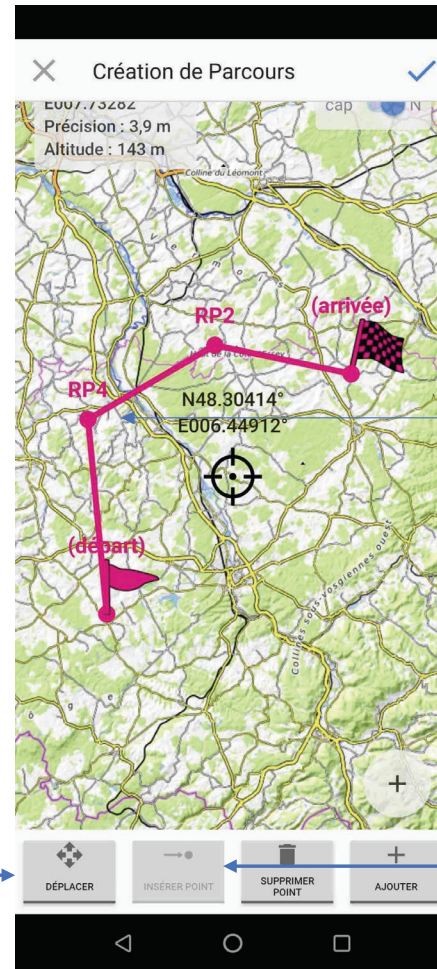
To do this, simply click on the screen to create the first point, then click again for the 2nd and so on.

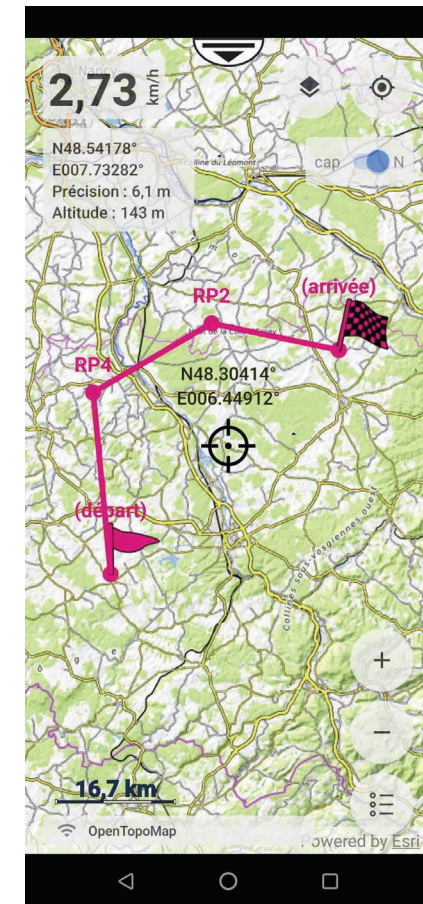
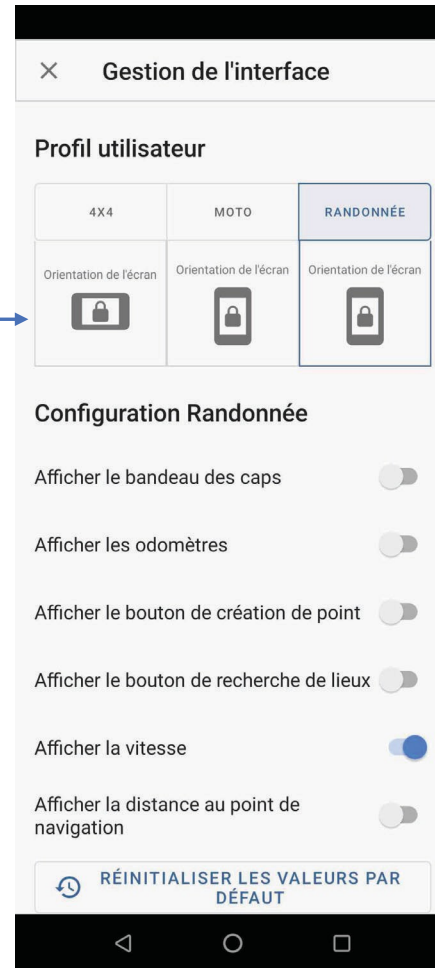
Interface 1 menu

You can choose your interface:

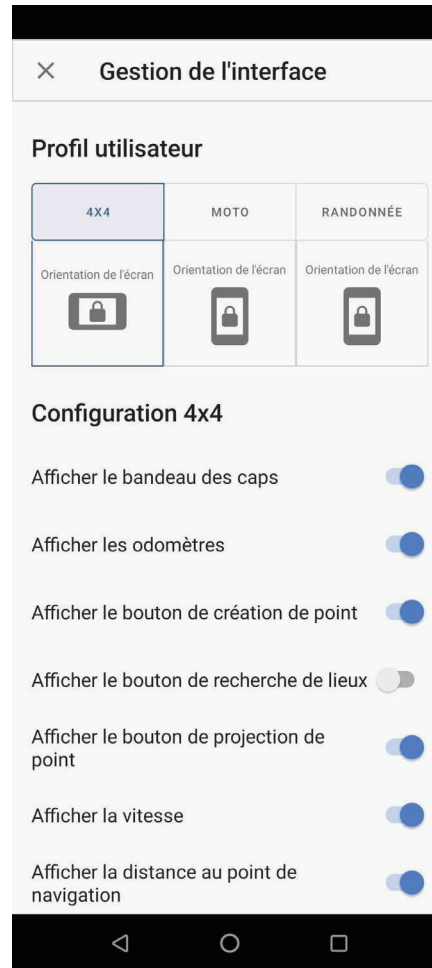
- 4x4

Interface 2 menu

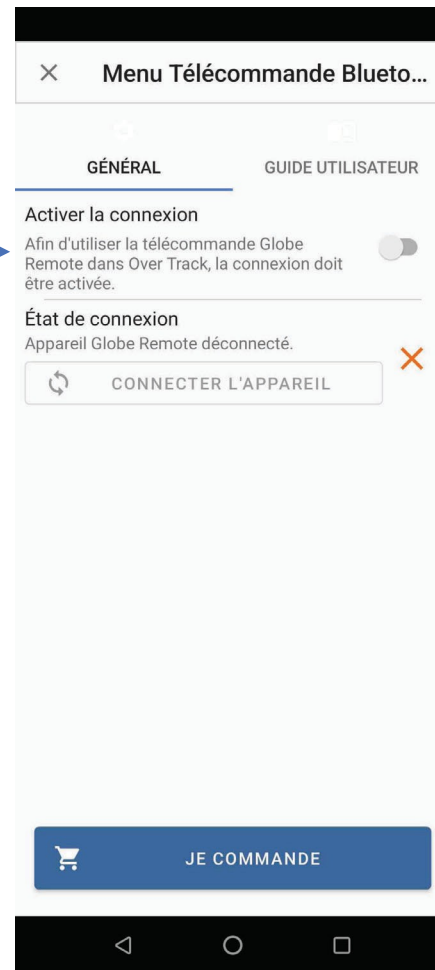


The 4x4 interface is in landscape mode and can be configured completely differently from the hiking interface.



Bluetooth remote control menu

To use the remote control, you need to activate the connection.



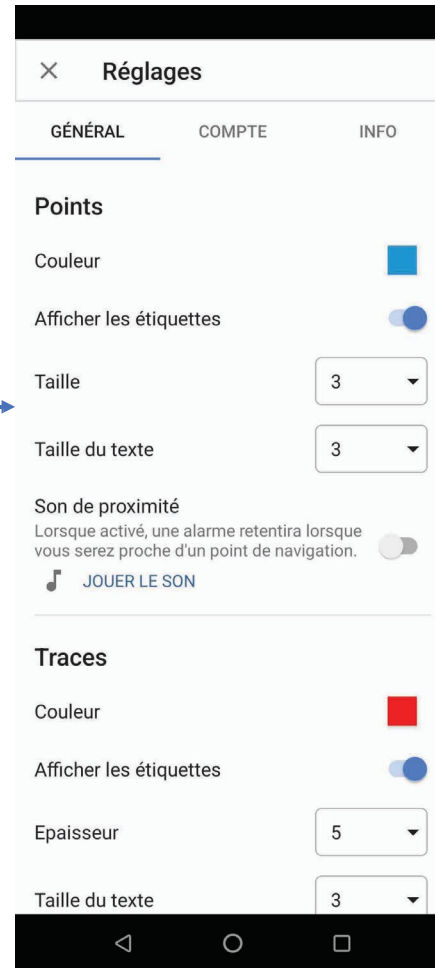
Then click on 'connect device'.



Once the connection is established, you'll see a green tick.

Settings menu 1

For GPS points, you can set the color, the size of points and associated text, and display its name (label), not forgetting the proximity alarm which warns you as soon as you approach a GPS point.

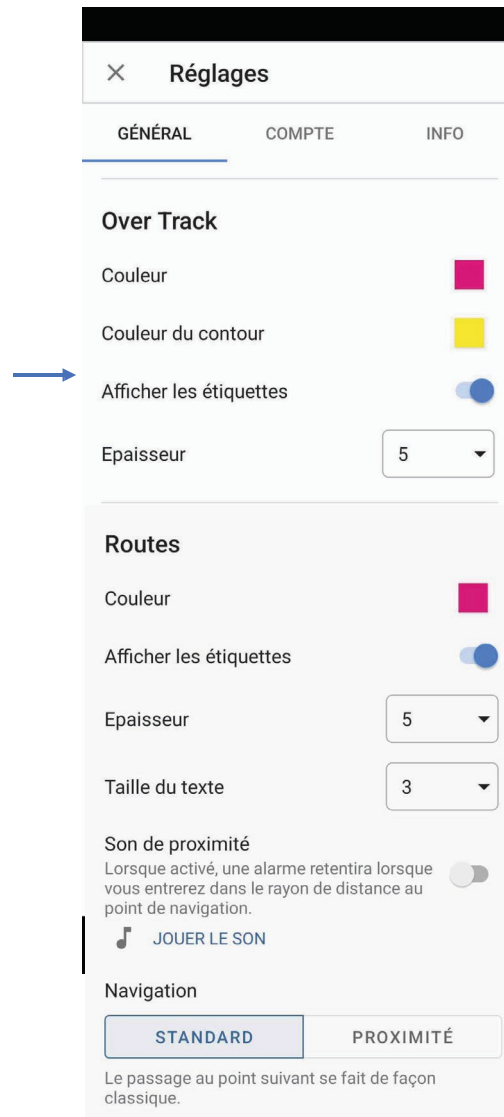


For tracks you can set color, line thickness, text size and display information (label).



Settings menu 2

For Over Track itinerary suggestions you can set the track color, and display information (label).



For roads you can adjust line color and thickness, text size and display information (label), not to mention the proximity alarm. which warns you as soon as you approach a GPS point.

Settings menu 3



You can decide whether or not to display the back track.


You can decide whether or not to display the target.

You can choose the card storage location:

- internal memory
- SD card.



You can have the cursor centered or not, and choose its color.

The map can be automatically centered on your position, or you can do this manually by clicking on the . In the 'auto' position, the map refocuses after an adjustable delay (between 1 and 9 seconds).

In the 'locked' position, it is not possible to move the map.

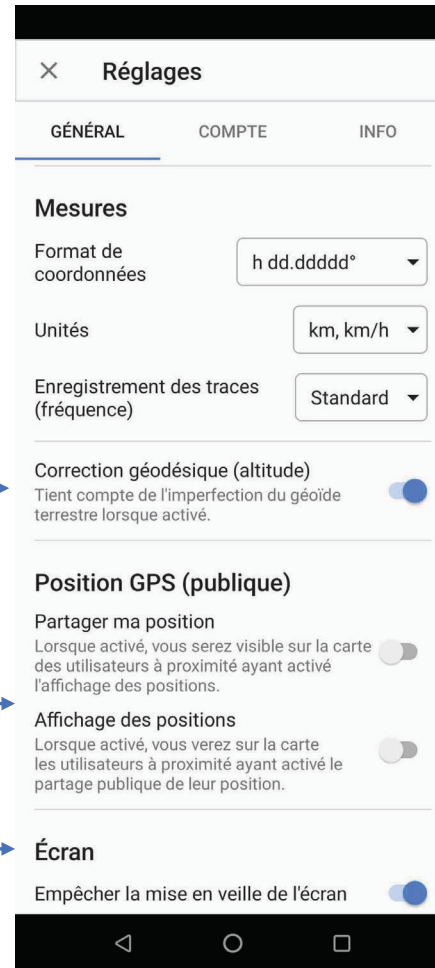

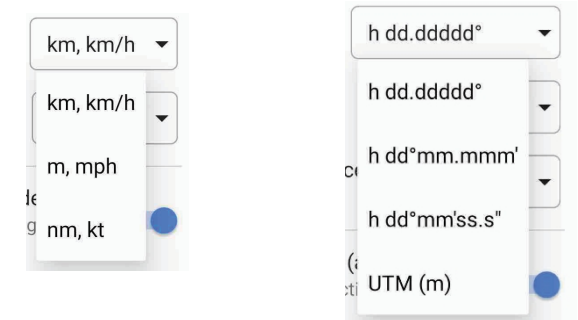
You can activate geodetic correction (altitude), which is necessary in some cases.

You can decide to make your position public.

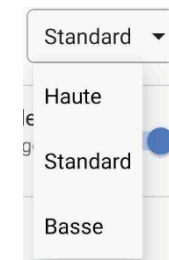
You can prevent the screen from going to sleep.
